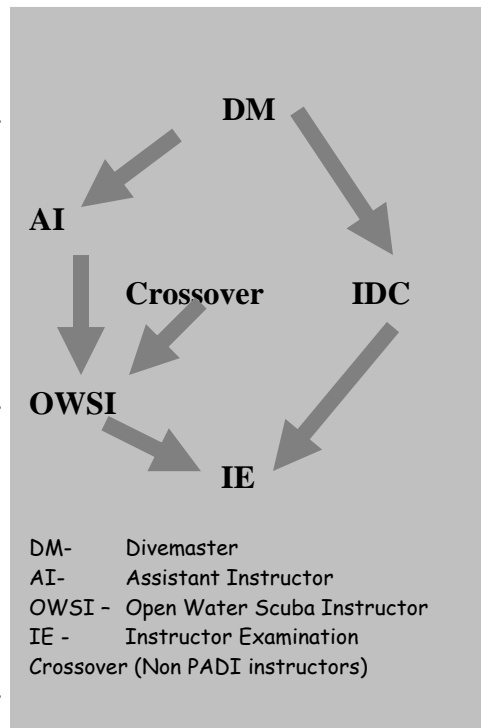

How can I prepare for the course OWSI (IDC)

Independent Learning

Prior to the start of an Instructor Development Course, Assistant Instructor Course or Open Water Scuba Instructor program, you must complete all **16 IDC Knowledge Reviews** found in the *Instructor Candidate Work book*. Complete Knowledge reviews may be accomplished by self-study using the PADI *Instructor Manual, Business of Diving, Law and the Diving Professional, The Best of Undersea Journal* and referring to recent Undersea Journal articles in the Instructor Candidate Workbook. Instructor Candidate Workbook is the most used manual during the Instructor Development course.

What are my prerequisites to join the course?

- Be certified as a PADI Divemaster or hold a leadership level certification with another recreational diver training organization. (Renewed for the current year).
- Be at least **18 years old**
- Be fit for diving and submit a Medical Statement for a diving medical examination conducted within the **past 12 months**. A licensed physician must sign the form and state that the **participant is fit for diving**. The physician signing the form may not be the applicant.
- Have been a certified diver for at least **six months** and have completed and logged at least 60 open water scuba dives and have documentation of experience in deep, night and navigation diving. Note: to attend an IE the instructor candidate must have at least **100 logged dives**.
- Submit documentation of any equivalent certification for entry level, advanced, rescue and leadership-level issued by another recreational diver training organization. (non PADI certifications)
- If not a **PADI** Divemaster, successfully complete the PADI Divemaster course diver rescue skills assessment.

- Have issued at least 25 PADI diver certifications.

Course Prerequisites

To enroll in a PADI IDC Staff Instructor course, an individual must:

1. Be renewed and in Teaching status as a PADI Instructor for the current year.
2. Hold a PADI Master Scuba Diver trainer rating.
3. Agree to conduct all levels of diver training consistent with the standards and philosophy outlined in the PADI Instructor Manual.
4. Agree to use the PADI System and components in its entirety.
